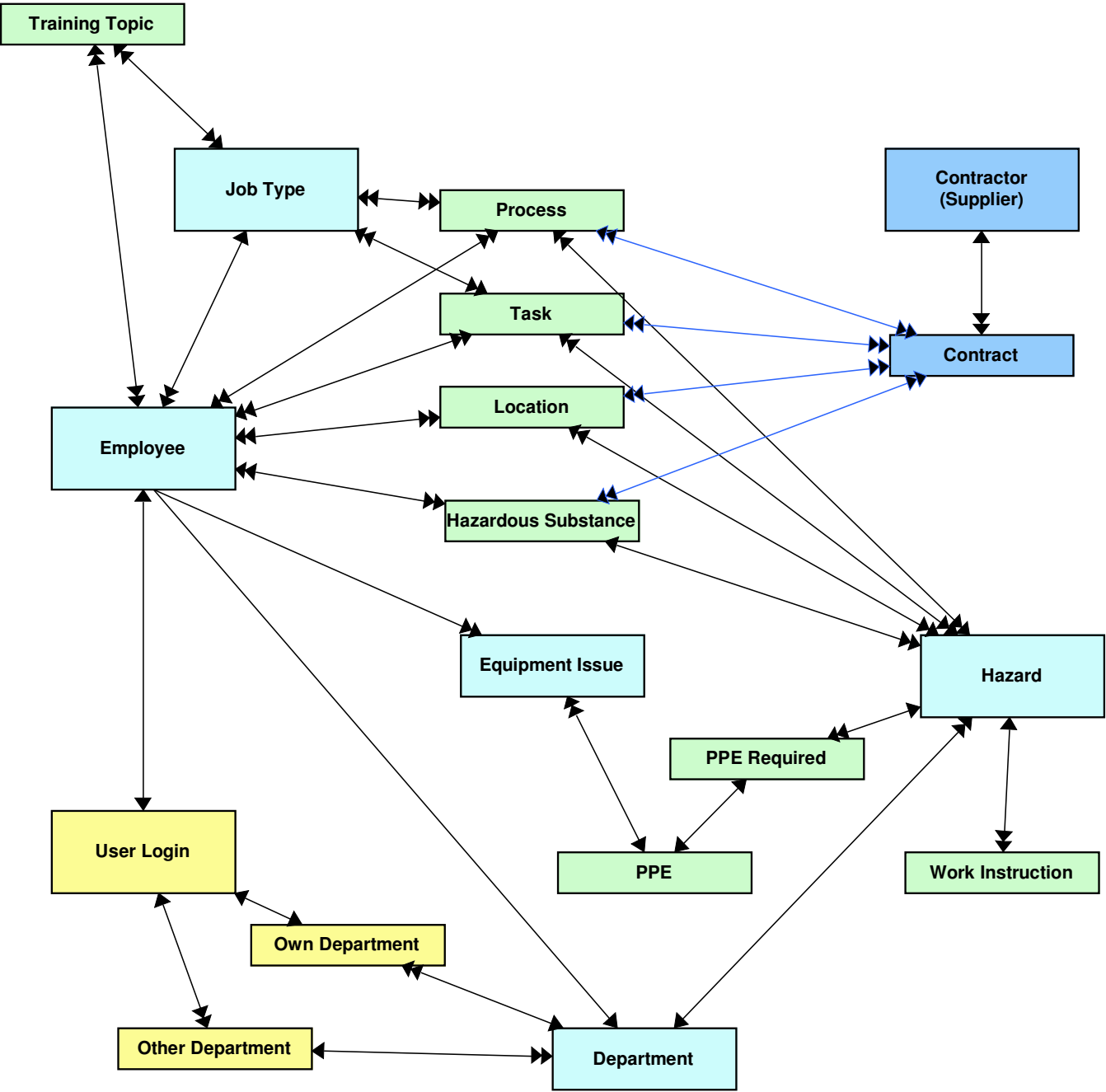


H&S Compliance Manager. Employee-Hazard and Contract-Hazard Relationships

Employees are not directly related to hazards in the HSE system, their relationship is dynamic. In employee data, the employee's exposure to hazards is via: processes, tasks, locations and hazardous substances. A contractors exposure is set from the individual contract (in suppliers). Similarly, hazards are related to processes, tasks, locations and hazardous substances. When required in reports HSE associates people and contracts to hazards using these relationships.



Departments may share hazards or they may be particular to that department. This option is set in the company information. When departments share hazards a user will see all hazards, regardless of their departmental view. However if hazards are not shared among departments a user will only see associated hazards in their departmental view. A user's departmental view is determined by their login options..
